**May 14 (Sat): Wild Flowers. 9:30-11:30. Northern Community Park. Leader: Mary Anne Borge, photographer and naturalist Bowman's Hill Wildflower Preserve.** Discover the diverse array of spring flowering plants on the Crosswicks Creek floodplain. Photographers welcome. Free. Meet at Bordentown Township's Northern Community Park on Groveville Road, between Rts. 130 and 206. (Contact / info: 732-821-8310).
