We take pride that this collaboration over the past year has led to a project called WE vs C in support of the Robert Wood Johnson Barnabas Health's new Cancer Center. The event will take place at the Grounds for Sculpture **June 3rd & June 4th**.

There are two main events—"A Night of Inspiration" fundraiser on **June 3**, and a multimedia celebration focused on awareness and healing on **June 4**. Both days will include food, beverages, music, art exhibits, and other entertainment in the beautiful Grounds for Sculpture setting. The highlight is a special performance by the Roxey Ballet entitled "Breast Cancer: Stories of Personal Triumph."

This event will have the support of several photographers from PPC. Barbara Warren's series "We Are More Than Our Diseases" will be featured. Tasha O'Neill and two new members Fran Eber & Susan Summerton are among 12 featured artists who will have their own booths.
