Our Club is a vibrant and exciting group of photography enthusiasts. We sponsor monthly speakers, schedule educational workshops, run two art galleries, and coordinate with other groups (e.g., Grounds for Sculpture, Pinelands Preservation Alliance, D&R Greenway Land Trust) on larger, long-term photography projects.

To do all this, we rely on volunteers. **To continue doing this, we need additional volunteers.** The more members who volunteer, the more activities the Club can undertake. We are currently seeking volunteers for the several roles listed below. Please consider volunteering your time and experience to help our Club.

Refreshment Chair

The Refreshment Chair takes responsibility of obtaining one or two volunteers for each general meeting who will provide refreshments, include setting up the refreshments table and cleaning up after the meeting. The chair then collects receipts and assures that the volunteers are reimbursed from the Club treasury for all reasonable expenses. The volunteers also ensure that serving trays and bowls, utensils, paper goods, etc. are available for subsequent meetings.

Publicity Chair

The Publicity Chair sees that notices of meetings and special activities reach suitable target audiences (via local newspapers, social media, websites, etc.), thereby promoting interest in the Club's programs within the community. The chair will also help develop and coordinate an effective publicity strategy for the Club.

Federation Representative

The Federation Representative is the main contact with the New Jersey Federation of Camera Clubs and attends their meetings. He or she will inform the Club members of the Federation's activities by way of notice at Club meetings and through the newsletter. The representative will oversee PPC participation in NJFCC juried contests.

Field Trip Coordinator

The Field Trip Coordinator identifies or solicits interesting places for club members to visit as a group and works with the individual trip leaders to manage the specific field trips. The Coordinator and trip leaders ensure that each trip is fully funded by the participants.

Vice President

The Vice President assists the President as necessary and officiates at all meetings in the absence of the President.
